UPDATE REGARDING POTENTIAL SECURITY RISK

On June 6, 2016, the Cambridge Institute of International Education, part of The Cambridge Network, reported that we had learned that certain data on one of our servers was potentially accessible by unauthorized third parties.

Since that time, we have conducted an extensive investigation into the incident, including engaging a third party forensic investigator. At the conclusion of this investigation, it was determined that a limited number of individuals had statutorily-protected information stored on the compromised server. However, forensic analysis found no evidence of any attempted or actual fraudulent misuse of this information.

As a result of this incident, we have worked internally and with the third party forensic investigator to take steps to tighten network security and increase safeguards to better monitor for vulnerabilities and to reduce the likelihood of a similar incident occurring in the future. In abundance of caution, and despite the lack of evidence of any fraudulent misuse of this information, we contacted all affected individuals to notify them of this incident.
